Healing in Her Throat & Esophagus

I will never forget Annette Phillips, whom I had met several years ago in a Friday Night Miracle Service. She had come specifically because she was having trouble hearing out of either ear. The Spirit of God was moving so wonderfully, individuals were being healed, worship seemed to be reaching the rafters and beyond. I looked around the room and could see hands lifted high and others bowing down to give God the best praise possible.

She came forward in the great altar service desiring to be healed! I remember laying my hand upon her and her receiving immediately. Most of all Jesus miracles happened instantly, why should we think it should take a week or even a couple of days to be healed. Jesus said, *Verily, verily, I say unto you, he that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father* (John 14:12).

Annette called about one month ago testifying of severe esophagus problems. Mainly she could not eat anything because it would not go down. Right away the Spirit spoke with complete directions. Get up in the morning and eat two crackers and drink a glass of water. When she rose up in that next morning, she did

exactly as God had directed her. She ate two saltine crackers, (which is the worst thing to eat when these kind of difficulties arise), and then she drank a glass of water. When she finished doing what God said to do, she knew something had happened. She made herself a sandwich, and was able to eat like anyone else. For more than two months, Annette has been free from this problem and praising God for his goodness!
